H. C. RICHARDS MEMORIAL PRIZE

This yearly prize commemorates the memory of Professor Henry Caselli Richards (1884-1947), one-time Chairman of Trustees of the Queensland Art Gallery. It was instituted by the Trustees in 1951 as a 100-guinea prize for landscape painting, the winning painting becoming the property of the Gallery. In 1957 the acquisitive clause was removed and the prize now is of 1,250 dollars for a painting of any subject in any medium, the Trustees retaining the first option of purchasing any work submitted, including the winning one.

L. J. HARVEY MEMORIAL PRIZE

This award is presented through the Trustees every two years by the Half Dozen Group of Artists in memory of Mr. Lewis J. Harvey, one-time instructor in modelling, woodcarving and pottery at the Brisbane Technical College, life member and trustee of the Royal Queensland Art Society and member of the Half Dozen Group. The prize is of 100 dollars for a drawing in any medium which becomes the property of the Queensland Art Gallery, with the consent of the Trustees.
