TRUSTEES' PRIZE 1972

This yearly prize will now be made in commemoration of a person who, in the Trustees' opinion, has rendered distinguished service to the development of art in this State.

For 1972 the award will be made in memory of Professor H. C. Richards (1884-1947), one time Chairman of Trustees of the Queensland Art Gallery. The prize was instituted by the Trustees in 1951 as a 100 guinea prize for landscape painting. The award winning painting is now acquisitive and the prize money is \$2,500 for a painting of any subject in any medium. The Trustees retain the first option until 31st October, of purchasing any work submitted.
